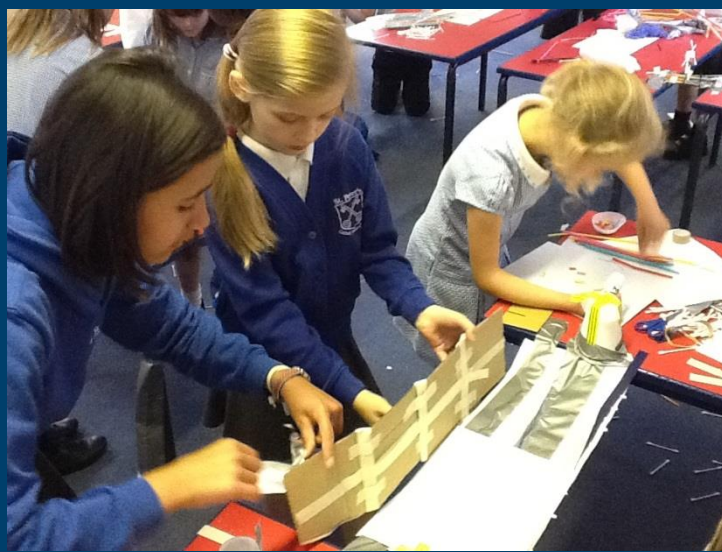

This week, we have been learning...



We have been finding out about fire safety in Class One this week. The children investigated the school area to find out where fire alarms, extinguishers and exits are. We watched short films on how to call the emergency services and what happens at the fire station once a call has been made. In RE we have written our own hymns of praise and thanks and then performed them back with the help of musical instruments. In Maths we have been sharing quantities into halves and quarters and brushing up on our 3D shape knowledge. The children had a very enjoyable visit to Leamington fire station on Thursday where they all got to 'squirt water' from the powerful hose which they all agreed was very exciting!

This week we have enjoyed thinking about the vocations of people who help us, in particular fire fighters. We really enjoyed a trip to the fire station to find out more. Following on from our topic last week on the Great Fire of London, we baked some delicious bread too.



Class 3 have had a brilliant week this week, starting off by being taught by Mr Rooney. He taught them lots of atlas skills as we learnt to be geographers. They then spent a creative day celebrating the feast of St Peter and Paul, with every child having a different favourite activity. They finished the week by leading a beautiful Mass to celebrate the children that received their First Holy Communion.

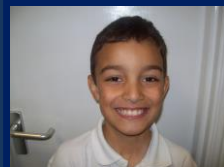
