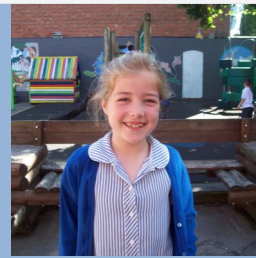
Class 1

Anna: for always putting 100% effort into everything!



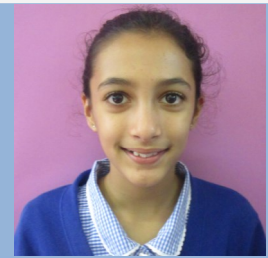
Class 2
